Subject: Training of Muslim Women in stitching, embroidery and
knitting - reg.

PREAMBLE.

A large number of Muslim women remain unemployed for various reasons. Quite often they cannot leave their houses to take up job in different places, thus human resources are wasted. They can be made potentially earning members of family if suitable opportunities are presented to them. Women who suffer economic handicap as well as social handicap may be widows, orphans, destitutes and housewives, these categories of women need to be encouraged.

One of such means to promote mobility among women is training in tailoring and also in embroidery and knitting. Given proper training facilities, such women can add to family income and sometimes they will be sole earning members. Therefore, the Karnataka State Wakf Foundation for Women Development has felt the desirability of taking up intensive as well as extensive training facility in State. These trained women can sit at home and earn or go to near by garment factories.

The Karnataka State Wakf Foundation for Women Development in its meeting held on 6-07-2009 under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Minister for Haj, Wakf & Minority Welfare has resolved to start the training programme in stitching, embroidery and knitting for the Muslim women in the State, from the current financial year. Therefore, this order.

ORDER NO. MWD 79 WFW 2009, BANGALORE, DATED: 27-10-2009

After careful examination of the matter the Government Order No. MWD 79 WFW 2009, dated: 24-09-2009 has been withdrawn and the Karnataka State Wakf Foundation of Women Development is pleased to sanction the scheme of training in stitching, embroidery and knitting for the Muslim women in the State to be implemented through the NGOs on the following conditions –

1. The training period would be for the duration of 6 months with 2 batches of 25-30 students per day.
2. The NGO's can adjust the timings of the training to suite the convenience of the trainees with a fixed time component such as both in the morning and afternoon.
3. The training shall be imparted by well qualified and committed trainers with vast experience in cutting and stitching.

4. The Honorarium of Rs.3500/- per month in respect of the trainer and Rs. 2000/- per month in respect of the Asst. Trainer will be borne by the Karnataka State Wakf Foundation for Women Development.
5. An amount of Rs. 100/- per month would be provided to each of the trainee for training material. This amount will not be given in cash but material will be supplied in the training classes. This expenditure would be met by the Karnataka State Wakf Foundation for Women Development.
6. At the end of the training period successful candidates will be provided with Sewing Machine subject to the condition that 50% of the cost shall be met by the trainees or the NGOs. And for orphan and widows Sewing machines will be provided free of cost by the Karnataka State Wakf Foundation for Women Development.
7. The NGOs should have their own infrastructure facilities. Preference will be given to those who have their own building or accommodation. Actual electricity and other maintenance charges will be borne by the Foundation.
